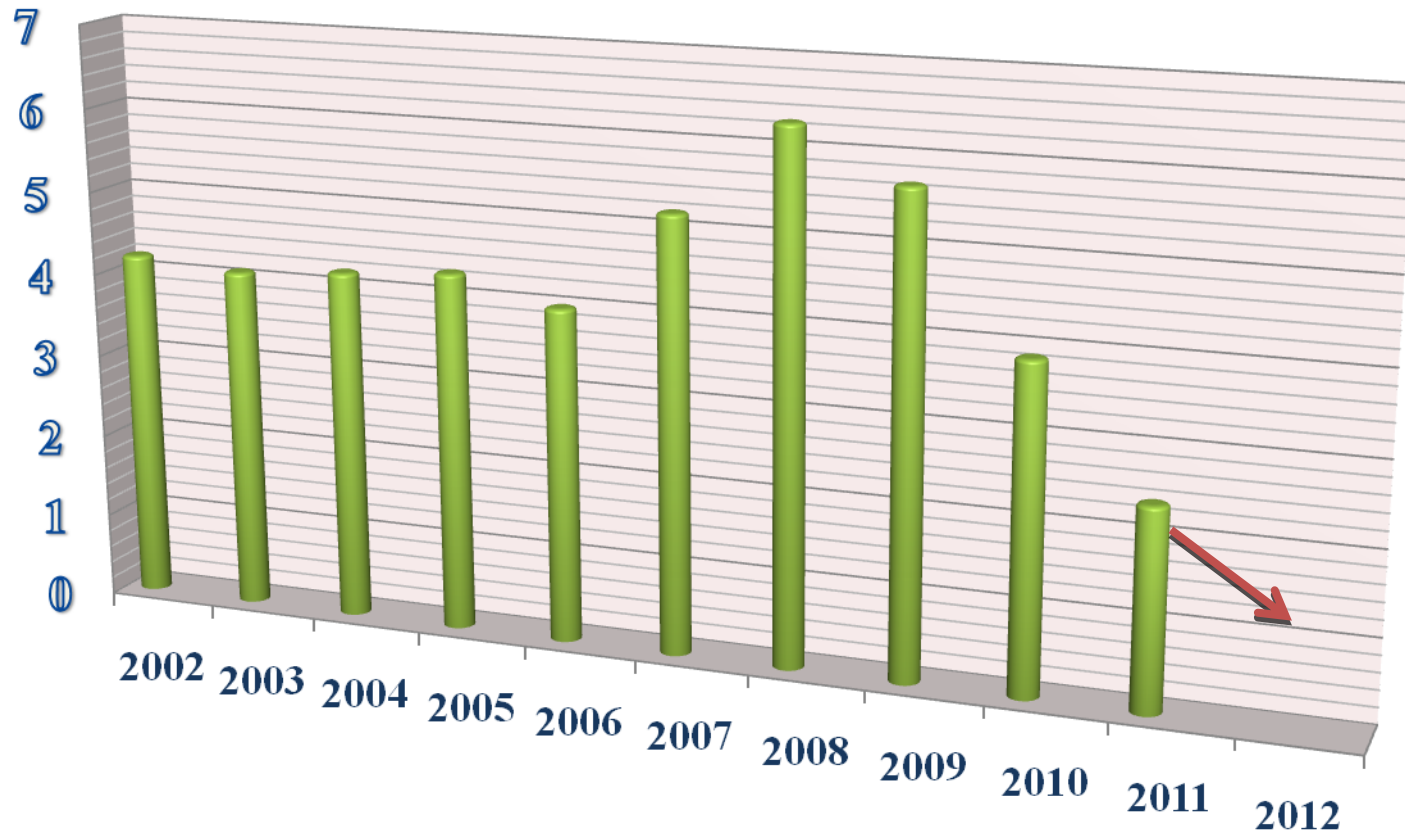

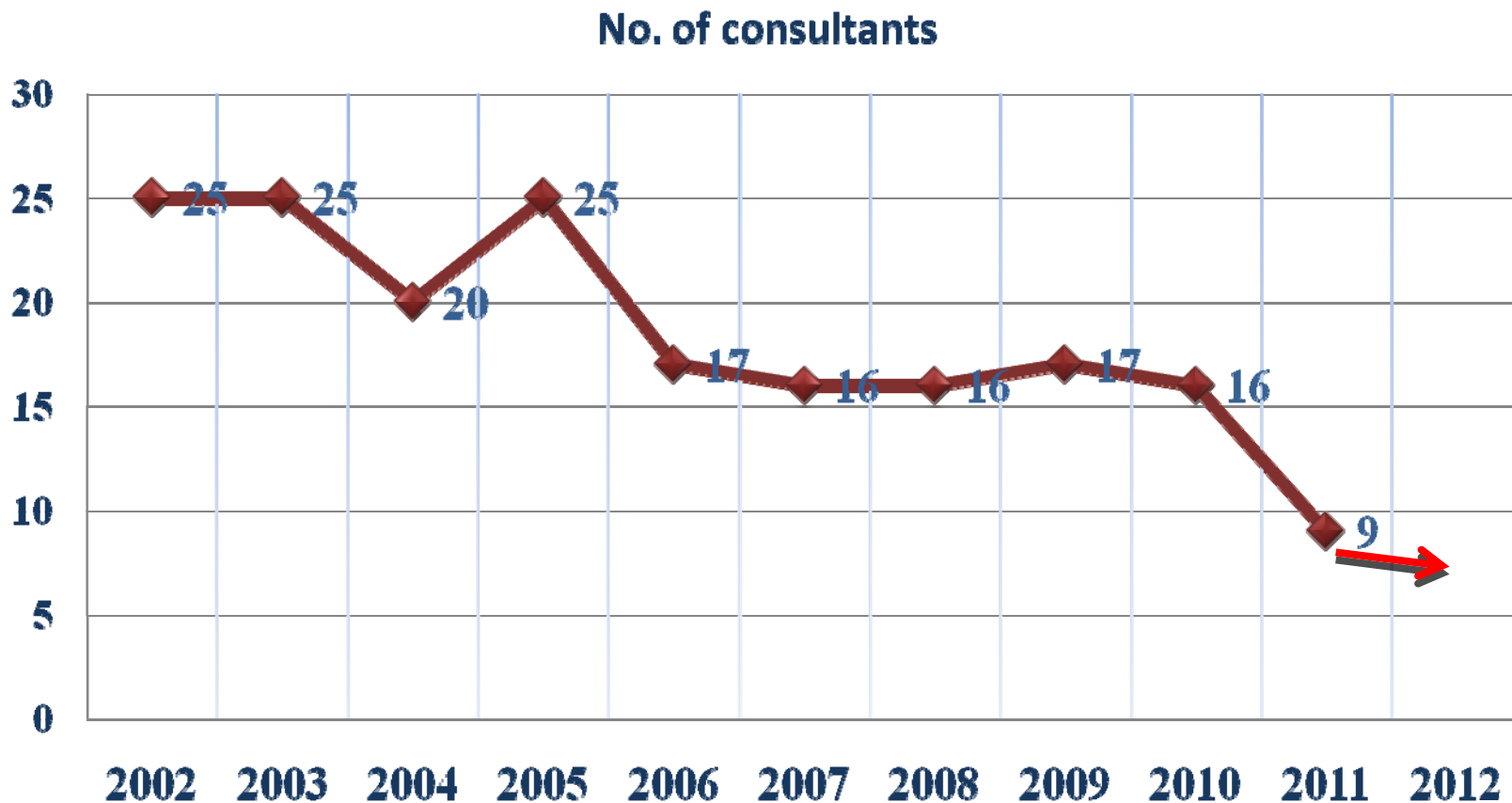
# PMU – expenditure during 2002 - 2010

## Overall Objectives:

- to provide recommendations on the above mentioned issues, as well as with proposals and recommendations regarding further actions, including potential amendments and/or supplements of the contracts;
- to provide with other legal consultations;
- to assess the evaluation of separate issues of the implementation of projects;
- to carry out the analysis of different interpretations of the application of legal acts of the Republic of Lithuania;
- to represent the interests of INPP with contractors, negotiate with them or other third parties and (or) competent institutions of the Republic of Lithuania, in arbitration or other dispute settlement institutions.



# Objectives and involvement into INPP activities



## Objectives:

- focus support activities on specific technical expertise on nuclear decommissioning matters is required;
- optimise an integrated approach to the overall complex decommissioning process, so that engineering and design, investments and licensing issues are optimised and that a comprehensive approach to the entire radioactive waste management process is assured;
- ensure effective management of the interfaces between all decommissioning projects;
- transfer of skills to enable INPP to become an efficient project management structure which will allow it to manage the complete decommissioning process itself.
