

1. Limitations for e-mail messages conditioned by INPP mail server configuration:

- The size of sent/received message shall not exceed 20 Mb;
- The number of recipients for one sent/received message shall not exceed 30;
- The maximum volume for user's with external mail-box rights is 1 Gb.
- The maximum volume for user's without external mail-box rights is 256 Mb.

2. Antivirus software configuration on mail server does not allow transmitting the following messages: with attachments:

- Liste.zip; reg_text.zip; word-text.zip; word-text_packedlist.zip; Cybil.zip; Richard.zip; admin.zip; akte.zip; download.zip; ebay.zip; email.zip; hostmaster.zip; list.zip; mail_body.zip; mailtext.zip; postman.zip; reg_pass.zip; reg_pass-data.zip; webmaster.zip

with extensions:

- *.asp; *.avi; *.b64; *.bat; *.bhx; *.bnd; *.class; *.com; *.cpl; *.dll; *.elf; *.exe; *.exe_;
*.gif; *.hlp; *.hqx; *.inf; *.lnk; *.mim; *.mp3; *.mpeg; *.mpg; *.pif; *.ra; *.ram; *.src;
*.sys; *.uu; *.uue; *.vbe; *.vbs; *.vxd; *.wav.

3. Antispam software configuration of INPP mail server defines the following messages as SPAM:

- When the field "Subject" is empty;
- There are words or symbols in the message specific for SPAM, for example "!!!!", "Viagra", "Winner", etc.;
- Message with attachment without any text in the message body;
- Message body contains only graphic image;
- Sender's address is in the blocked addresses list;
- Sender's internet domain is in the blocked domains list.

4. Limitations for e-mail messages associated with INPP mail client policy:

- E-mail attachments which were split by Outlook Express can be unreadable.
