



MEMO TO INPP VISITORS

1. INPP nuclear sites are protected by security systems and guarded by armed security officers. Video surveillance is in use. Persons can enter and leave the sites via checkpoints with badges issued by INPP. All persons, vehicles and packages entering or leaving the sites are subject to inspection.

2. Before entering the site visitors must attach the badge at chest level in the way it stays clearly visible and get their passport ready before entering to the checkpoint area.

3. Visitors can proceed to the checkpoint area only with an escort. Visitors must stay with their escort at all times after entering the site.

4. Visitor badges must be worn at all times. Inform your escort immediately if you lost your badge.

5. Before entering the checkpoint empty your pockets and place items for x-ray scanning.

6. Personal belongings and other items, for which permission to bring into the site was not granted, can be placed in the lockers.

7. It is obligatory to comply with all legal demands of an escort, INPP Physical security organization service and Nuclear Facilities Physical Protection Unit personnel.

8. It is **FORBIDDEN** to:

8.1. bring in firearms, ammunition, weapons, explosive, inflammable, poisonous materials, alcoholic beverages, narcotic drug;

8.2. bring in and remove from the site items, which are not included in the permission documents;

8.3. bring in computers, internal and external hard disks, equipment for filming or photograph and other devices that can be used to take photos or film, excluding mobile phones, without corresponding documents;

8.4. take photos and film without INPP granted permission and violating procedure;

8.5. attempt to enter the site while being under the influence of alcohol (the concentration of alcohol in exhaled air exceeds 0.15 per mille) or psychotropic substance;

8.6. attempt to enter the site (buildings, rooms) without authorized access;

8.7. bring in food and face cosmetics to the controlled radiation areas;

8.8. strike, organize demonstrations and other disobedience acts;

8.9. violate other INPP physical security rules and procedures.

9. Visitors who violate physical security procedures will not be allowed to enter the site or will be escorted off the site. INPP will report violations to law enforcement agencies.

10. Persons failing to observe INPP security rules will be held liable according to the legal acts of the Republic of Lithuania.
