Law on Public Procurement of the Republic of Lithuania!

How much does the INPP purchase?



Procurement budget for 2020 is ~127 390 000 EUR

Including:

Goods ~20 400 000 EUR

Services ~35 900 000 EUR

Work ~71 090 000 EUR

Design ~800 000 EUR





How much does the INPP purchase?

Reserved and / or spent ~38 700 000 EUR

Including:

Goods ~10 700 000 EUR

Services ~12 000 000 EUR

Work ~71 090 000 EUR

Design ~700 000 EUR



Short procurement statistics in 2020:



Procurement procedures:

~180 procedures (procurement of services and work);

~ 640 procedures (procurement of goods).



- 49 purchases via CVP IS.
- ~180 contracts concluded (in written form)





SE INPP — Nuclear Facility (NF) Specific requirements:

- ISO 9001 certificate, quality assurance plan, supplier's audit
- License (issued by VATESI) for the performing of activity in the ionizing radiation environment
- Verification of supplier's personnel (State Security Department)



Financing by European Union:

- Funds of the European Union Ignalina Programme (administrator Public Institution Central Project Management Agency).
- Funds are made available through the Ignalina International Decommissioning Support Fund (IIDSF)
 (administrator European Bank for Reconstruction and Development). The one-off contributions to IIDSF
 are also had been provided by bilateral donors

Financing by Lithuania


- SE Ignalina Nuclear Power Plant Decommissioning Fund (administrator – Public Institution Lithuanian Energy Agency).
- The funds accumulated by the SE Ignalina Nuclear Power Plant,
 the income from investment activity of the enterprise, the income from commercial activity
 (rent of premises and buildings, transport services, etc.).
- Funds from the State Budget.

Obtaining of the necessary permissions.




